Color Coded Approach Plan 2020/2021

---GREEN---

****COVID is a minimum risk to our school community.***

- All in-school learning.
- Enhanced cleaning of materials.
- Frequent cleaning of high – touch areas.
- Daily temperature checks & health screening questionnaire for all students, staff, parent visitors and volunteers.
- Drop off / Pick up outside at front doors.
- Masks for ages 10+ years old (including staff, volunteers, and visitors) when social distancing is not possible.

---YELLOW---

****COVID is at a moderate risk to our community.***

- All procedures from Green plus:
- Increased separation of combined class times.
- Staggered recess times.
- Classroom bathroom breaks.
- Staggered drop off / pick up times.

---RED---

****COVID is at a high risk for our school community and positive case detected.***

- Switch to a virtual learning platform for 10 total days to allow time for professional sanitization of building.
- Virtual learning platform will consist of staggered class times.
- Individual(s) that test positive must remain quarantined for 14 days and test negative before returning to in person classes.
- It will be recommended that all individuals in contact get tested.

Additional Information:

- If a student's temperature is over 99 degrees, they must be fever free without fever reducing medication for 48 hours prior to returning to school.
- If a student or family member tests positive for COVID we must receive documentation of a negative result before that student returns to school.
- Check with school staff before making travel plans between August-May to determine if student must delay return to school for 7 or 14 days.
- Please be cautious of gatherings of over 100 people throughout the school year as these tend to be places where the virus can spread easily. If a student attends a large event, we may require they delay their return to school for 7 to 14 days.

Thank you for your cooperation as we navigate this school year together.
